Team Delhi - Project Matritva

focused on supporting pregnant women from financially backward communities in accessing Government welfare schemes. One of the success was an end to end safe delivery of a community woman including hospital and all expenses.



Team Ahmedabad - Project RRR

centered around the theme of reduce - reuse - recycle. Used clothes were collected and distributed in low income communities at a nominal cost. The funds raised were used to support the project. Over 25,000 clothes were reused through the project.



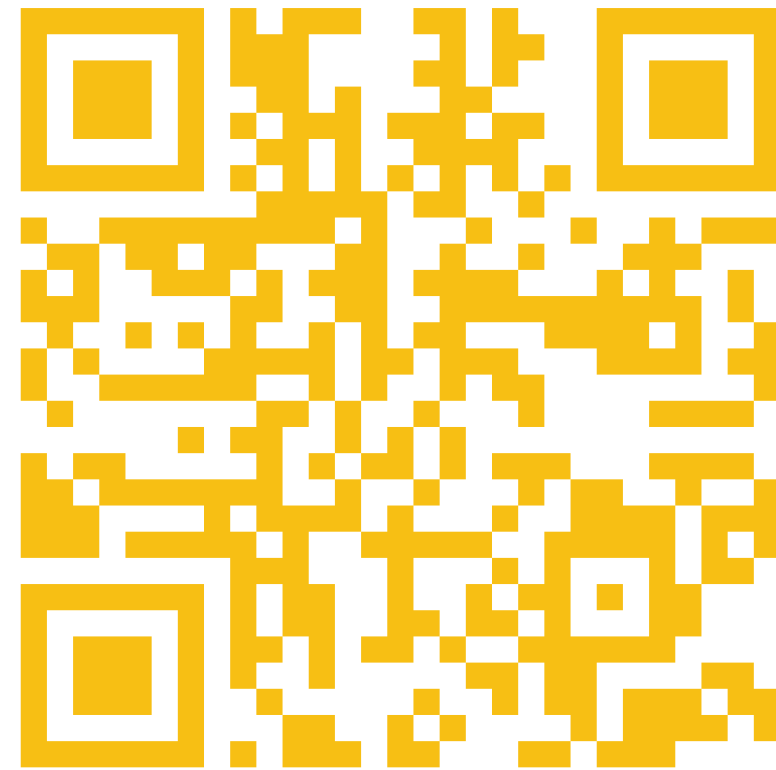
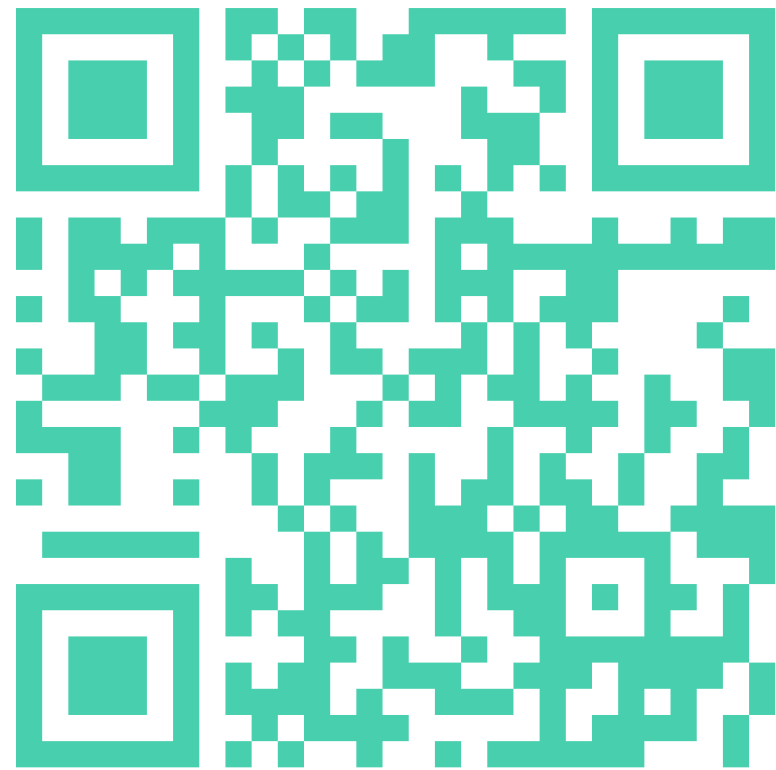
Team Guwahati - Project Xarothi
